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Articles should generally not exceed 8,000 words. Each submission should be accompanied by a cover letter with the author's name, address, phone number, and e-mail address, as well as a brief biographical statement, an abstract, and five to six keywords. Research articles to be considered for publication are refereed anonymously, and the author's name should appear only on the cover sheet. Manuscripts must be prepared according to the most recent edition of the Chicago Manual of Style, with double-spaced notes at the end of the text. References should be formatted according to the Chicago Style of (Author date, page) for in-text citations and a References Cited list following the endnotes.

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
