Membership in the Society of Architectural Historians

Membership is open to all who are interested in furthering the study, interpretation, and conservation of architecture and its related arts. In addition to receiving the Society's quarterly journal, *JSAH*, and newsletter, members can participate in the annual conference and attend study programs at reduced rates. Access to the *JSAH* archive (1941–present), the multimedia edition of *JSAH* online, and SAHARA are available with Individual and Professional Associate memberships in the Society. *SAH Archipedia* is now open access. SAH membership includes free access to all SAH CONNECTS programs, the SAH CONNECTS Video Library, and access to the SAH Commons scholarly networking site.
