In addition to receiving the Society's quarterly journal, *JSAH*, and newsletter, members can participate in the annual conference and attend study programs at reduced rates. Access to the *JSAH* archive (1941–present), the multimedia edition of *JSAH* online, and SAHARA are available with Individual and Professional Associate memberships in the Society. *SAH Archipedia* is now open access. SAH membership includes free access to all SAH CONNECTS programs, the SAH CONNECTS Video Library, and access to the SAH Commons scholarly networking site.
